TIPS COLUMN BY WENDY BERRY - THE LOB SERVICE

Lethal weapon if played consistently and predominantly to the backhand. Aim about a racquet's length from the front wall out line using an "up and under" action with very little pace. Hang time before gravity pulls the ball deep to the back is the important thing. Ball should glance the side wall beyond the service box above head height before hitting the floor. Once hitting the floor, the ball should travel in a direction parallel with the back wall. A fair amount of solo practice will be necessary to get the "feel" of this action.
